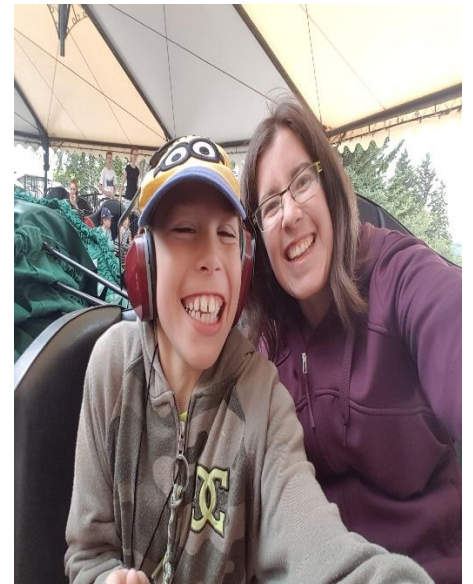

Tuition Reminder

Please note that the remaining balance of \$12,000.00 tuition is payable to the Janus Academy Society in two installments; the first installment of \$10,000 shall be paid in full on or before June 16, 2017. The final balance is due September 5, 2017. A \$500.00 late fee will be charged and added to this total if the first installment payment of \$10,000.00 is not received by the June 16, 2017 due date. If full payment is not made by September 5th of the current school year an additional 2% interest will be charged per month thereafter on the remaining balance. We recommend sending in a postdated cheque to guard against any late fees being applied.
