Hello Everyone,

Welcome back to school. Where did the summer go? I hope you all had a great summer break and are now ready to dive back into the school routine.

Our first community event was to have been our Family Picnic on August 31, but due to inclement weather, we had to postpone the event. I was sorry that we couldn't meet up before school started, but we can't control the weather.

We will, however, have the opportunity to meet as a community on September 14, 2023, at our mandatory Parent Meeting. I am looking forward to reconnecting with our returning families and welcoming our new families. We have increased our student population to 85 students this year, an increase of 5 additional spaces at Janus since last year. This represents a total growth of 20 student spaces since we moved into our new school in 2020. This was our first Summer Camp since COVID closed us down a few years ago and we welcomed 115 campers to our six-week sessions. I look forward to working with all our families, students, and staff to continue our journey and to ensure we are fulfilling our Mission of "Empowering and supporting persons with autism and their families, maximizing their quality of life by providing the model learning environment that meets their academic, social and emotional needs".

Newsprint is a low-cost, non-archival paper consisting mainly of wood pulp and most commonly used to print newspapers and other publications, as well as advertising material, such as grocery store flyers. The paper needs to be non-waxy, non-glossy and able to absorb water. <u>Invented in 1844</u> by Charles Fenerty of Nova Scotia, Canada, newsprint usually has an off white cast and distinctive feel. If you have any newsprint you would like to donate to Janus Academy, please do not hesitate to drop it off at reception during regular school hours from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.








Welcome Back!






